## SHAW BARLOW OFFICE RENOVATION

The renovation of the main floor for Shaw Communications' Barlow facility began with a challenge to cohesively connect four individual sections of their existing 100,000 sq.ft. main floor, each one added onto the next over a span of 14 years, into one singular dynamic and engaging space. Through intensive collaboration with Shaw's in-house design team, including a team from iN Studio Creative, an innovative plan was developed to break the massive floorplate into individual Neighbourhoods using a concept of topography and cityscapes. These Neighbourhoods provide distinctly designed areas for different operational teams within Shaw's organization and are connected through the "Path" – a dynamic angled corridor system that provides instinctive wayfinding to amenity and work spaces, access to shared meeting spaces and small "jewel-box" breakout spaces for impromptu conversations.
