Kasian is the Prime Consultant for the \$300m Calgary Courts Centre (CCC). At approximately one million square feet with 73 courtrooms, the CCC is the largest of its kind in Canada and the third largest in North America.

Designed as two towers connected by a 26-storey glass atrium, this sustainable, contemporary, and public friendly space was created to meet the growing needs of the Canadian Justice System.

A number of design drivers were identified through collaboration with key user groups. In addition to unique public space requirements, sustainability, circulation, flexibility, and transparency were identified as critical to operational success.

The design focuses on creating a sense of serenity, and the glass atrium instills a calming effect on courthouse employees and visitors. The extensive use of glass symbolizes the accessibility of the Justice System, and provides unparalleled access to daylight and views. This abundance of natural light also permits more contrast between materials and finishes, emphasizing deliberately placed elements of visual interest throughout the space. Consistent application of materials and finishes throughout the building further helps to foster visual continuity and cohesiveness.
